BOIL WATER NOTICE

5/11/25

Due to a WELL CONTROL FAILURE AT ONE OF OUR WELL SITES, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required that a "Boil Water Notice be issued for the public water system for the following areas: ALL OF REDLAND COMMUNITY, AND US HWY 204, TRAWICK, OAKFLAT AREA. CARO WATER SUPPLY HAS A WELL DOWN AND WAITING FOR COMPANY TO REPAIR.

Caro Water Supply Corporation /CCN# 10417 to notify all customers to boil water prior to consumption. (washing hands, face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc.) Children, seniors, and people with weaken immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria, and all customers should follow these directions).

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for TWO minutes.

In lieu of boiling, individuals may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source of drinking water or human consumption purposes.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, Caro Water Supply Corporation will notify customers when the boil, water notice has been rescinded, and NO LONGER necessary to boil their water.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water.
